NOTIFICATION

No. 01/IGR-Kolkata, the 7th June, 2010. — In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of section 69 of the Registration Act, 1908 (16 of 1908) as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the following amendments shall be made, with immediate effect, in the West Bengal Registration Rules, 1962, published with the Judicial Department notification No. 541-Regn., dated the 26th April, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules):—

Amendments

In the said rules, —

(1) in rule 45,—

(a) in sub-rule (1),—

(i) after the words, figures and brackets "under sub-section (1) of section 25", *insert* the words, letters and brackets "by cash or by Bank draft and/or by Serialised Authenticated Bank Receipt (SARB)";

(ii) after the words "shall enter the respective amounts", *insert* the words "or shall enter the particulars of Bank draft or Serialised Authenticated Bank Receipt (SABR), as the case may be,";

(b) in sub-rule (2), after the words "and the fine(if any), paid", *insert* the words, letters and brackets "in cash and/or by Bank draft and/or by Serialised Authenticated Bank Receipt (SABR)";

(2) in rule 118, in sub-rule (3), to the first proviso, *add* the following proviso:—

"Provided further that the fees paid by Bank draft and/or by Serialised Authenticated Bank Receipt (SABR) for registration of documents as prescribed in sub-rule (1) of rule 45, shall be remitted in the same manner as stated in sub-rule (2) of the said rule along with the fees paid in cash."
