MEMORANDUM

In connection with the Bye-election to 10 Pre-delimited Assembly Constituencies in West Bengal as mentioned below, scheduled to be held on Saturday, the 7th November, 2009, the undersigned is directed to say that the State Govt. employees who are ordinarily residents and bonafide voters of the under mentioned Assembly Constituencies but serve elsewhere in an office where Saturday is not observed as holiday, may be given facility to exercise their franchise on the said day if applied for in writing, by way of sanctioning late arrival at office or early departure therefrom or a short absence on that day subject to exigencies of public service. The State Govt. employees who are residents and bonafide voters of the under mentioned Assembly Constituencies but are employed in an office where Saturday is not observed as holiday, located at such a distance, that it is not possible for them to exercise their franchise without absenting themselves from their offices, may be allowed special casual leave on that day, if applied for by them.

The undersigned is further directed to say that as per the directive of the Election Commission of India, the day of dispatch i.e. the day before the Poll-day may be declared as a local holiday for the educational institutions located with the Assembly Constituencies, if the day of dispatch happens to be a teaching day for those institutions.
